

## Tangerine Melt and Pour Loofah Soap

### Supplies Needed:

- 16 oz. Melt and Pour Shea Butter Soap Base (I use Stephenson brand)
- .34 ounces or 2 tsp. Tangerine Essential Oil
- Molds (either buy silicone molds or use Pringles cans, yogurt containers, inserts to cracker variety packs, use your imagination!)
- Slices of loofah (you can buy it in whole pieces and cut yourself, it's cheaper that way!)

\*The above quantities can be adjusted to how much soap you want to make. If you are making the soap from the 'take and make' kit from the library just snip the bottom corner of the oil packet when it's time to mix it in!

### Procedure:

1. Cut up the soap base into small squares and melt on medium power for 30 second increments until fully melted. It takes about 2 minutes. Stir in between each 30 second interval and be careful to not over heat. Heat just until melted.

Ideas for molds



2. Add Tangerine Essential Oil, to the melted soap base and stir in.

3. Place a slice of loofah in your mold and then pour in the soap base and allow it to cool and harden



4. After it hardens, remove from molds. It takes about an hour for smaller pieces of soap, a little longer for big pieces.



5. If it's a gift, put it in a cellophane bag with a tag and an orange piece of string.



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
